ZoomIn Photo-Sharing Site Launched in India

ZoomIn, a photo-sharing website was launched in India on Friday. The website enables users around the world to store, share and print digital photos.

The site offers unlimited digital photo storage capacity, and simple to use editing tools for tweaking up pictures. It also lets users share photos through a widget in their blogs.

ZoomIn will also deliver prints to all major cities in India. The company has partnered with a local shipment provider to give low-cost overnight shipping with tracking. The company's customer service and software development teams will be located in Mumbai.

The price per print range from Rs. 4 to Rs. 40 for 4x6 prints to 8x10 prints respectively. To celebrate the launch of ZoomIn, the company is offering 100 free 4x6 prints on 20 September – customers pay only for shipping.
