ZoomIn is a new online photo site that enables you to store, share and print digital photos.

An Indian start up co-founded by Sunny Baliyepalli and Phiroze Havaldar, ZoomIn allows users to order prints for uploaded photos. These can be delivered to major cities in India within one working day. According to the website you can also send prints to the US, though the delivery time is seven-10 days. The website claims to be cheaper than most competitors, with prints priced at Rs 4 to Rs 40 for 4x6 prints to 8x10 prints.

The website also allows you to share your photos through a widget in your blog or website, and has invite-only and public security settings to control how you share your albums. It offers unlimited storage and anytime access to hi-resolution originals.

The website is fast becoming popular among Indians abroad for whom it is a convenient way to share photographs with relatives in India without burning a hole in their pockets.
